Professor Dr. Glenda Crosling presented her keynote speech entitled Enhancing Teaching and Learning in Higher Education: Preparing Students for the Future. In her keynote speech, Prof. Dr. Glenda Crosling highlighted the importance of the educational programmes offered to students. She discussed the importance of students' development through their higher education aspects such as flexibility in thinking, interacting collaboratively, critical thinking, problem solving and the capacity for creative thinking. Examples were given of ways to assist students to develop these capacities.

Assoc. Prof. Dr. Jonathan Newton presented his keynote speech on teacher roles in learner-centered education. His focus is on teacher skills in structuring effective learning experiences, motivating learners, and shaping learning. He presented three case studies of EFL teachers in action in Malaysia, China and Vietnam. He shared the lessons that can be learned from these teachers on (1) effective teaching for learning and (2) enhancing the way to educate teachers in the future.
